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GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION

GENERAL APPLICATION INFORMATION

- 1.1 Emfuleni Community College online and paper-based admission application cycle opens on 01 November for first Semester and 1st of April for second Semester of every year.
- 1.2 Each prospective student must complete only one application form. On the application form, kindly indicate your first and second choice in terms of what you wish to study.
- 1.3 Once your application form has been processed you will receive an acknowledgment email, whatsapp or SMS, with a reference/student number.
- 1.4 If after processing your application and you meet the general minimum entry requirements you will be issued with a provisional admission letter, which merely says you have been accepted into the chosen or considered program, subject to your entry qualification recommendation and or an English and Maths pass in your final National Senior Certificate results.
- 1.5 **Receiving either an acknowledgment letter or provisional admission letter does not imply that you have been accepted without registration done by the students.** Admission is a separate process your application undergoes after being evaluated by the relevant department.

HOW TO FILL IN THE APPLICATION

- 2.1 The form must be completed in full.
- 2.2 The paper-based and online application form, when submitted, must be accompanied by:
 - All relevant supporting documents (ID Copy, Matric Results, etc.) NB: all documents must be certified.
 - Proof of bank payment of R150.00 for all paper-based hardcopy application forms irrespective of your nationality, race, colour and gender.
- 2.3 For your own protection, cash payment must not be made or included when submitting your application to the College.
- 2.4 Your paper-based application form must be submitted by hand or email to: The College Admin, Emfuleni Community College. SEBOKENG OFFICE Or VEREENIGING OFFICE
- 2.5 The College reserves the right to reject or withdraw your application if you provide incorrect, incomplete, illegible or fake documents
